

JSCA Ad Hoc Marginal Wharf Committee
Meeting Minutes
June 20, 2007

1. Marginal Wharf

Richard previewed the meeting objective to sketch conceptual ideas supporting the framework of 3 key areas of interest to the JSCA from the previous meeting:

- I. Increase the beach area available for small, naturally powered craft.**
- II. Increase the Jericho Sailing Centre compound to the east with a gate to access the “Marginal” area.**
- III. A more effective facility to support the Disabled Sailing Association.**

Discussion of accessing the beach space and a dock facility via an extended Jericho Sailing Centre compound. The sandy beach area could give a favourably protected launch for paddlers and novice windsurfers.

Accommodating the DSA will require about 200 linear feet of dockspace. The facility would require heavy duty power to operate lifts/winches/hoists etc.

The Committee discussed the concept of a building in the new NE corner of an extended compound which would contain offices for the Kayak & Windsurfing Schools as well as the DSA office and washrooms accessible to the public within operating hours.

The committee discussed the potential size of the compound extension and noted that it should match up with the beach access as well as the new dock facility.

Mark Scott presented a conceptual sketch showing an extended compound, dock facility and a portion of the east section of the Marginal Wharf remaining as a strolling and viewing area. Committee members tweaked the concept by orientating the entrance to the dock facility to the east.

Peter Wall has volunteered to develop our conceptual sketch further for presentation to the Park Board.
