

# NOTICE OF RACE

## 2010 Flights of Spring Regatta

April 17 & 18, 2010

### **1 RULES**

- 1.1** The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2** CYA prescriptions will apply as well as the Equipment Rules of Sailing to the extent that they apply, the rules of the participating classes and this Notice of Race.
- 1.3** If there is a conflict between this Notice of Race and any Preliminary Notice of Race, this Notice will govern.

### **2 ADVERTISING**

- 2.1** Advertising will be restricted to Category "C".

### **3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

- 3.1** Skippers wishing to register boats in this event must be members of Good Standing of a recognized yacht/sailing club/association or National Authority.
- 3.2** Eligible classes are the International Laser, the International Laser Radial, the International Tasar, the International Hobie 18, the International Hobie Tiger and the International Nacra F18.

### **4 FEES**

- 4.1** The entry fee for the single-handed boats shall be \$20.00 CAN. The entry fee for the double-handed boats shall be \$30.00 CAN.
- 4.2** Competitors may pay their entry fee at registration, 1300 Discovery Street, Vancouver, BC. Please make any cheques to: Jericho Laser Fleet.
- 4.3** Competitors may make alternative arrangements for payment by contacting the regatta chair, Andy Hunt.

### **5 SCHEDULE**

- 5.1** Racing for all classes will take place on Saturday, April 17, 2010 and on Sunday, April 18, 2010.
- 5.2** Registration will take place on Saturday, April 17 between 10:00 hrs and 12:00 hrs. at the Jericho Sailing Centre, 1300 Discovery Street.
- 5.3** The scheduled time for the warning signal of the first start of the first race on April 17 is 13:00 hrs. The scheduled time for the warning signal of the first start

of the first race on April 18 is 11:00 hrs.

- 5.4** The competitors' meeting will be at 12:00 hrs. on April 17 at the Jericho Sailing Centre.

## **6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

- 6.1** The Sailing Instructions will be available at registration on April 17, 2010.

- 7.4** There will be a limited number of tents allowed in the Jericho compound.

## **8 VENUE**

- 8.1** The venue for this event will be the Jericho Sailing Centre, 1300 Discovery, Vancouver, BC. The sailing will take place on English Bay.

## **9 PENALTY SYSTEM**

- 9.1** RRS 44.1 and 44.2 will be in effect for all classes except the multihulls. For the multihulls, RRS 44.1 and 44.2 are modified in that a multi-hull shall be required to do one 360 degree penalty turn including one tack and one gybe.

## **10 SCORING**

- 10.1** The Low Point scoring system in Appendix A4.2 will apply.
- 10.2** One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 10.3** (a) When 4 races or less have been completed, a yacht's score will be the total of her race scores.  
(b) When from 5 to 9 races have been completed, a yacht's score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.  
(c) When 10 or more races have been completed, a yacht's score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

## **11 THE COURSES**

- 11.1** There shall be two courses with a shared mark (see course diagram)
- 11.2** The course to be sailed shall be displayed on the starting line boat no later than the preparatory signal for each class.
- 11.3** The course to be sailed are as follows: all marks to be left to port.
- 11.4** A course diagram will be included with the sailing instructions.

FLAG	COURSE	MARKS
1	Standard Triangle	Start – 1 – 2 – 3 – Finish

- 2 Windward – Leeward Start – 1 – 2 – Finish
- 3 Bermudan Triangle Start – 1 – 2 – 3 – 1 – 3 – Finish
- 4 2 X Windward – Leeward Start – 1 – 3 – 1 – 3 – Finish
- 5 Windward – Leeward (Multis) Start – 3 – 4 – Finish
- 6 2 X Windward – Leeward (Multis) Start – 3 – 4 – 3 – 4 – Finish

**11.5** Courses may be shortened or abandoned according to RRS 32.

## **12 PRIZES**

**12.1** There will be prizes for the top three sailors in each class as well as prizes for top master and top youth in the Laser Class. There will be prizes for the top open and top female sailor in the Laser Radial Class. In addition, there will be some draw prizes.

## **13 SOCIAL**

**13.1** There will food and drinks available from the cafeteria after racing.

## **14 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

**14.1** Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4 Decision to Race. The organizing authorities, the Jericho Laser Fleet and the Jericho Sailing Centre Association, will not accept any liability for material or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.
